3R Program for University Waste (UzSWLU)



Description:

As part of the 3R program, we have carried out several activities aimed at reducing waste, reusing resources and recycling them.

Waste reduction:

- We conducted an audit of current processes and identified areas where waste can be reduced. For example, we have optimized the use of paper in the office by replacing it with electronic documents. This reduced paper consumption by 20%.
