[3] Waste (WS)

At the university, inorganic waste may include:

- Household waste (paper, cardboard, plastic, etc.).
- Laboratory waste (chemicals, glass, metals).
- Construction waste (remnants of building materials, pipe and wire trimmings).

For proper waste disposal, universities usually have special containers for different types of garbage. For example, there may be separate tanks for paper, plastic, and glass. Waste from laboratories is collected in special sealed containers, which are then sent for disposal. Construction waste must also be collected separately and removed from the university grounds.

Description:

The total inorganic waste produced on our campus includes:

- laboratory waste (chemicals, glassware, metals);
- construction waste (building materials, pipes, wires);
- electronic waste (computers, monitors, printers);

The volume of each type of waste depends on the activities that take place on campus. For example, if many laboratories or construction projects are going on, the amount of laboratory and construction waste will be higher.
