[3] Waste (WS)

At the university, inorganic waste is usually recycled or disposed of.

For example, paper and cardboard can be recycled to produce new paper products. Glass can be recycled into new glass products. Plastic can be recycled into various materials such as plastic granules or fibers.

Waste from laboratories is collected in specially sealed containers, which are then sent for disposal due to safety requirements. Construction waste must also be collected separately and removed from the university grounds.

For the disposal of electronic waste (computers, monitors, printers), you should contact specialized companies licensed to work with hazardous waste. They are engaged in their safe recycling or disposal.

Description:
