- As part of the "Youth Shoulder" project organized in Germany, on July 23, 2024, Dilshoda Alisherova, a fourth-year student from the Faculty of English Language and Literature at the Uzbek State University of World Languages, participated in an 8-day training session in the city of Weimar, Germany.
