Description:

As part of implementing the ZEV policy, the university has conducted several activities to raise awareness among students and staff about the importance of using zero-emission vehicles.

Educational events:

Lectures and seminars on the topic of ZEV were organized, where the advantages of such vehicles, their impact on the environment, and the prospects for market development were discussed.

Modules on ZEV were included in the courses on ecology and sustainable development.

Research activities:

Studies have been conducted to assess the current state of the ZEV market in the region and its potential for further development.



Recommendations have been developed to encourage the use of ZEV among students and university staff.

Practical measures:

Electric scooters and bicycles were rented for students and staff, which allowed them to assess the benefits of using zero-emission vehicles.

Cooperation with partners:

The University actively collaborated with the local authorities, car manufacturers, and public organizations to promote the idea of ZEV and develop joint projects.

Evaluation of the results:

After all the events, a survey was conducted among students and staff to assess their level of awareness about ZEV and readiness to use such transport. The survey results showed a significant increase in interest in ZEV after the events.

Further plans:

Based on the results obtained, the university plans to continue promoting ZEV, including developing new educational programs and research projects. It is also intended to expand cooperation with partners to create more favorable conditions for the use of ZEV.
