

The staff's productivity results highlight the active involvement and contributions of the teaching and research faculty in advancing knowledge, meeting societal needs, and strengthening UzSWLU's connections with the broader community. This includes the faculty's commitment to conducting high-quality research, publishing in reputable journals, securing competitive grants, and collaborating on projects with external partners. Furthermore, it encompasses their participation in community service, such as offering expertise, consultation, and outreach programs to address local concerns. The staff's overall productivity serves as a key indicator of the university's dedication to generating and applying knowledge for the public good.

During the last 3 years, more than 200 professors with academic degrees have been involved in scientific supervision/advisory. 550 researchers are conducting research on doctoral dissertations as doctoral students, basic doctoral students and independent researchers. 1,819 articles were published in foreign journals, 1,200 articles were published in republican journals, and 1,189 theses were published in international conferences and 1,087 abstracts were published in republican conferences.

UzSWLU always supports scientific research. The achievements of scientists are applied to practice, programs are developed based on their results, priority directions of innovations are determined, modern teaching methods are created, and projects and software are created within the framework of the project. Scientific councils, scientific research institutes, and modern scientific research institutes for the acceptance of doctoral theses (DSc) and doctor of philosophy (PhD) dissertations in a number of specialties to carry out theoretical and practical research and integrate the results of scientific research into educational, research and social activities laboratories operate. The university is becoming a platform for conducting scientific research to solve current problems. As a result, the integration of science, education and production is being implemented.

The main focus of education at UzSWLU is teaching and learning languages. The group of experts work on the needs of the firms, companies, and organizations and support services that are reliable and relevant to them, such as the integration of language with science subjects. The current researches are carried out in actual fields such as neurolinguistics, cognitive linguistics, cognitive literature studies, corpus linguistics, ecocriticism, etc. This indicates that the UzSWLU is preparing not only pure social science personnel but also the scope of the research at the university, which aims to connect social and science subjects.

There are eight research institutes under UzSWLU and each institute has their working programs. They are

- 1) Theoretical and Practical Linguistics Research Institute;
- 2) Literature Studies Research Institute;
- 3) Translation Studies Research Institute;
- 4) Methodology of Teaching Foreign Language Research Institute;
- 5) Media and Communication Research Institute;
- 6) Ecology Research Institute;
- 7) Validation Research Institute;
- 8) Study of Social Conditions Research Institute.

Moreover, there are 18 research laboratories concerning the university's specialties.

Staff research informs the design and implementation of community service initiatives by providing evidence-based insights and fostering collaboration with stakeholders. Professional development opportunities, such as workshops, seminars, and conferences, help staff members enhance their research and community service skills, stay current with best practices, and expand their professional networks. Staff’s engagement in research and community service activities is integral to their ongoing professional development and growth, and institutions play a vital role in supporting

and recognizing their achievements in these areas.

The university's staff demonstrate a strong research culture, evidenced by high publication rates in domestic and international journals, as well as active faculty involvement in scientific supervision and advisory roles. The research outputs contribute meaningful insights to their respective fields and inform impactful community service initiatives that address societal needs.
