Founded in 1949 as the Tashkent Pedagogical Institute of Foreign Languages, the Uzbekistan State University of World Languages (UzSWLU) has a proud history of more than 70 years of academic excellence. Following its merger with the Republican Institute of Russian Language and Literature in 1992, UzSWLU has established itself as the national leader in foreign language education, intercultural studies, and translation training.

Today, UzSWLU educates around 23,000 students in more than 20 foreign languages, offering 15 bachelor's and 13 master's degree programs. The curriculum combines strong theoretical knowledge with practical skills, emphasizing the inseparable link between language and culture.

The university comprises specialized faculties such as English Philology (1st, 2nd, and 3rd), Romano-Germanic Philology, Russian Philology, and Translation Theory and Practice, where students master English, German, Korean, Japanese, Chinese, and other global languages. In addition, UzSWLU is home to the Faculty of International Journalism, where students specialize in international journalism, political science, and international relations. This faculty equips future professionals with critical skills in media, diplomacy, and global communication — areas essential for promoting transparency, intercultural dialogue, and sustainable development in today's interconnected world.

UzSWLU currently operates **five campuses**, of which **four are located in Tashkent city**, while a newly established campus has recently opened in **Angren**, **Tashkent region**. The expansion into Angren reflects the university's commitment to widening access to higher education, reducing regional inequality, and fostering sustainable urban development through modern, eco-friendly facilities.

Beyond academic excellence, UzSWLU is actively committed to **sustainability and social responsibility**. The university runs the institutional program "Sustainable Language, Sustainable World", mandatory for staff since 2021, promoting sustainable lifestyles, energy efficiency, and environmental awareness. Its green campus initiatives include eco-friendly infrastructure upgrades, waste reduction programs, and student-led ecological campaigns.

Graduates of UzSWLU have gone on to successful careers as translators, teachers, journalists, diplomats, and international experts, contributing to Uzbekistan's integration into the global





community. Their achievements underscore the **prestige**, **sustainability values**, **and international reputation** of the university both at home and abroad.
