






UzSWLU Campus Setting Description

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) is an urban-based institution located in the capital city of Tashkent and the regional city of Angren.

All four campuses in Tashkent — including the Main Campus, Faculty of English Philology, Faculty of International Journalism, and Faculty of Russian Literature — are situated in high-density urban areas, characterized by multi-storey residential buildings, developed transport infrastructure, educational facilities, and commercial zones.

These locations are within or near the city center, ensuring easy accessibility for students and staff, as well as close integration with the city's educational and social infrastructure.

The Angren Campus, located at 182 O'zbekiston Mustaqilligi Street, Angren City, Tashkent Region, represents a regional academic hub and serves as a strategic extension of UzSWLU's educational activities beyond the capital.

The Uzbekistan State University of World Languages (UzSWLU) operates a network of campuses that together provide a modern, sustainable, and inclusive educational environment.

Main Campus (Uchtepa District, Tashkent)

The main campus is located in the Uchtepa district of Tashkent city, covering a total area of 23,361 square meters, of which than 13,000 square meters more spaces. This landscaped green balance between infrastructure and greenery creates a sustainable and eco-friendly learning environment. The campus includes six academic buildings, two student dormitories, and a large canteen with the capacity to serve up to 5,000 students daily. Facilities for student well-being include a gymnasium, football field tennis court, and basketball court.



Faculty of English Philology Campus (Uchtepa District, Zakovat-4)



Located in the Uchtepa district of Tashkent, the Faculty of English Philology campus is one of the largest and most comprehensive facilities of UzSWLU. It includes **five student dormitories** providing accommodation for local and international students, a **large canteen**, a **gym**, and a **sports hall** that supports physical education and extracurricular activities.

The campus also features a **football field** for outdoor sports, **two libraries** that provide access to academic resources, and a **laundry service** to support student well-being. In addition, the **Spirituality and Enlightenment Center** operates

on campus, promoting cultural, ethical, and civic education among students. Academic instruction is delivered across four academic buildings, each equipped with classrooms, lecture halls, and





language laboratories. This integrated infrastructure ensures that students benefit not only from highquality education but also from modern living and recreational facilities in a sustainable campus environment.

Faculty of International Journalism Campus (Chilanzor District, Lutfi-8)

Located in the Chilanzor district of Tashkent (Lutfi-8), the Faculty of International Journalism campus provides modern facilities for academic and professional training in the fields of international journalism, political science, and international relations. The main academic building is designed to accommodate up to 1,000 students, offering an advanced learning environment that combines theory with hands-on practice.

The campus is equipped with a specialized library, language laboratories, and professional sound recording studios that



allow students to gain practical skills in media production and communication. In addition, the campus houses a **student canteen** that supports daily needs and a fully operational **University Press Center**, which functions as a hub for student journalism, media projects, and university-wide publications.

This campus serves as a vibrant platform where future journalists, political scientists, and international relations specialists acquire essential academic knowledge and practical expertise, while also contributing to intercultural dialogue and sustainable communication practices.



Faculty of Russian Philology Campus (Chilanzor District, Mukumi-104)

Located in the Chilanzor district of Tashkent (Mukumi-104), the Faculty of Russian Philology campus is designed to serve up to 1,500 students. The campus provides a modern and inclusive academic environment that combines traditional philological studies with advanced resources for language learning and cultural exchange.

The facilities include a **student canteen**, a **specialized library**, and **language centers** that support intensive Russian and comparative philology training. A **sports**

hall is available to promote student well-being and physical development, while the library and study areas are designed to encourage independent research and academic excellence.

This campus plays a key role in preparing specialists in Russian philology and related fields, while also fostering intercultural communication skills that are essential for Uzbekistan's multilingual and multicultural environment.





UzSWLU Angren Campus (Tashkent Region)



In 2024 UzSWLU expanded its infrastructure by establishing a new campus in Angren, Tashkent region. The official address is: Tashkent Region, Angren City, Uzbekistan Independence Street 182.

This campus reflects the university's commitment to widening access to higher education, reducing regional inequality, and promoting sustainable urban development. The Angren Campus is equipped with modern, ecofriendly facilities that ensure students outside the capital have access to the same high-quality education and resources as those in Tashkent.
