Main Campus Area (UzSWLU, Tashkent, Uzbekistan)

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) is a leading higher education institution located in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, specializing in foreign languages, linguistics, journalism and international education.

The university operates a **main integrated campus** in the **Uchtepa district** and several affiliated facilities in **Chilonzor**, **Angren**, and **Orta Chirchiq**. The overall campus system represents a compact, sustainable model of higher education infrastructure within an urban environment.

Main Campus (Uchtepa District)

The Main Campus of UzSWLU, located at 21 Kichik Halqa Yoʻli Street, G-9A neighborhood, unites all major educational, administrative, and residential buildings within a single contiguous territory. The campus encompasses the Rectorate and administrative offices, academic and residential buildings, an international students' dormitory, a university hotel, a modern library, a sports facility, and auxiliary service units, including the central boiler system.

The total land area of the Main Campus is 72,165 square meters (0.072 km²). Approximately 45% of this area (≈32,500 m²) is devoted to green and landscaped



zones, featuring tree-lined walkways, lawns, gardens, Mandriopen courtyards that provide natural shade and improve air quality.

The compact layout minimizes internal transportation needs, promotes walkability, and supports the university's commitment to low-emission campus planning.

Other Facilities

In addition to the main campus, UzSWLU manages several complementary facilities that extend its academic and social impact:

Orta Chirchiq Recreation Complex	Orta Chirchiq District, 200A Sayilgoh Street	8,000	A rest and wellness facility for staff and students, equipped with recreational spaces, cafeteria, language corners, and a Spiritual and Enlightenment Center hosting cultural-educational training programs.

Total Green Area

Across all campuses, UzSWLU maintains approximately **60,000 square meters of green area**, representing around **38% of the total land area**.

The university actively expands its green zones each year through its "Green Campus Initiative", supported by faculty, students, and staff.





Key Green Strategies:

- Annual tree-planting campaigns across all campuses;
- Drip irrigation and moisture control systems;
- Introduction of native and drought-tolerant plants to reduce water use;
- Integration of green roofs and vertical greenery on selected academic buildings (pilot stage in Zakovat Campus).

These initiatives directly contribute to SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), SDG 13 (Climate Action), and SDG 15 (Life on Land).

Sustainability Narrative

UzSWLU's campus network illustrates a **compact, high-density educational model** where academic excellence and environmental sustainability coexist. The university's **45% green coverage** within its main campus and a **total of 38% green ratio** across all facilities position it as a leading institution in sustainable campus management in Uzbekistan.

Through its ongoing "Barqaror Til, Barqaror Dunyo" (Sustainable Language, Sustainable World) program, UzSWLU integrates environmental awareness into education, ensuring that students not only learn languages but also the values of ecological stewardship.
