[1] Setting & Infrastructure

[1.8] The ratio of open space area to total area

This indicator measures the proportion of open (non-built) spaces within the total campus area of Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU). Open spaces include green zones, sports fields, pedestrian pathways, recreational lawns, and other non-constructed areas that support educational, social, and environmental sustainability.

Data are based on cadastral measurements and campus infrastructure records for 2025.

Data

Indicator	Description	Area (m²)	Percentage (%)
1.5	Total Campus Area	156,348	100
1.6	Green/Open Space Area	≈ 60,000	38
1.7	Built-up (Building) Area	≈ 96,000	62

Calculation

Open Space Ratio = (Total Green and Open Space Area / Total Campus Area) × 100

Open Space Ratio = $(60,000 / 156,348) \times 100 = 38.4\%$

Final Ratio: approximately 38% open space coverage.

UzSWLU maintains a sustainable balance between built-up and open spaces, with approximately 38% of its total campus area dedicated to open and green zones. These areas include landscaped gardens, lawns, tree-lined walkways, sports fields, and cultural event spaces across all campuses (Main, Zakovat, Mukimiy, Lutfiy, and Angren). They serve as important venues for outdoor learning, recreation, and community engagement, enhancing air quality, aesthetics, and student well-being.





The university regularly conducts tree-planting campaigns, green fencing, and landscape maintenance programs organized by the Department of Ecology and the Spiritual and Enlightenment Centers.

The ratio of open space area to total campus area at Uzbekistan State World Languages University equals approximately 38%, ensuring a sustainable balance between natural and constructed environments. This ratio reflects the university's commitment to environmental sustainability, climate resilience, and livable campus design in alignment with the UI GreenMetric framework.


