[1] Setting and Infrastructure (SI) 1.20 Asphalt Surface and Parking Infrastructure

Uzbekistan State University of World Languages (UzSWLU) continues to modernize its transport and urban infrastructure under its Green Campus and Mobility Program, ensuring that all road, parking, and open-surface areas are environmentally friendly, safe, and educationally enriching.

In 2025, the university carried out a large-scale modernization of asphalt and parking zones across its campuses, with a special focus on eco-permeable surfaces, solar-powered facilities, and inclusive design. The total asphalt and parking area amounts to 17,200 m², of which 1,200 m² (7%) has been converted into eco-parking using grass-concrete and permeable asphalt technology that supports natural water absorption and reduces surface heat.

During 2025, new eco-parking areas with drainage-friendly surfaces were created, and all major internal roads were equipped with LED lighting, rainwater channels, and tactile paths for visually impaired students. Maintenance is performed twice per year by the Infrastructure and Technical Services Department to ensure quality and safety.

A major innovation of 2025 was the creation of the Lingua Park, initiated under the personal leadership of the university's Rector. The park represents a unique educational and cultural landscape where elements symbolizing England, France, China, Egypt, and the United States are integrated into the design. This space not only beautifies the campus but also provides students and visitors with a multicultural outdoor learning environment that promotes language learning, creativity, and sustainability awareness.

Furthermore, solar-powered parking shades were installed on the main campus, and bicycle infrastructure was expanded — the number of bicycle stands increased from 90 in 2023 to 160 in 2025, encouraging low-emission transportation among students and staff.

Through these efforts, UzSWLU combines functionality, sustainability, and education within its campus infrastructure, supporting the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs 9, 11, and 13) — *Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure; Sustainable Cities and Communities; Climate Action.*
