1.20 - Security and Safety Facilities

The Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) maintains a comprehensive, multi-layered, and fully operational security and safety management system to protect more than 17,000 students, 1,600 academic and administrative staff, and hundreds of daily visitors across all campuses. This system is designed in accordance with international safety standards and local emergency regulations to ensure a secure, responsive, and resilient university environment.

It encompasses preventive, monitoring, and emergency-response mechanisms, combining human vigilance and smart digital technologies. All academic, administrative, and residential buildings are equipped with modern **CCTV systems**, **fire alarms**, **emergency exits**, **first-aid stations**, and **trained security personnel** who operate in 24-hour rotational shifts, ensuring constant supervision and rapid reaction to any incidents.

Security Infrastructure

- CCTV coverage: 412 high-definition cameras installed across all campuses, ensuring 100% monitoring of entrances, corridors, parking areas, and open spaces.
- Central Monitoring Center: Located at the Main Campus, operated by the IT and Safety Departments for real-time supervision and recording.
- **Security personnel:** 30 trained guards (including 8 female officers) work in three shifts under the Department of Campus Safety.
- Campus Police Branch: A local Department of Internal Affairs (MIA) branch operates within UzSWLU, employing three male and two female police officers. They provide onsite protection, manage emergencies, and ensure public safety during all university events.
- Access control: Electronic ID-based gate system and visitor registration protocol implemented at all main entrances.
- **Emergency communication:** Direct connection between security posts, rectorate, and local emergency services (police, fire, ambulance).

Safety Infrastructure

- **Fire alarm and suppression systems:** Installed in all 42 buildings and connected to local fire and emergency departments.
- Emergency exits: Marked with illuminated photoluminescent signs; accessible from every point within 30 meters.
- **First-aid facilities:** 21 medical stations and first-aid cabinets maintained by the Health and Safety Unit.
- Campus lighting: 178 LED streetlights and 52 solar-powered lamps ensure safe nighttime mobility.
- Evacuation plan: "Emergency Preparedness and Evacuation Procedure" approved in 2024 and updated in 2025.

Training and Preparedness

- Annual **fire evacuation drills** and **first-aid training** sessions are organized for students, teachers, and administrative staff.
- Collaboration with the **Ministry of Emergency Situations** and the **Uchtepa District Fire Department** for regular safety inspections and simulations.





- Safety briefings are mandatory for all new employees and first-year students.
- Safety maps, posters, and QR-coded evacuation instructions are displayed in all buildings.

Digital and Preventive Systems

- CCTV system integrated with the **SmartSafety digital alert platform** for rapid emergency notification.
- Motion and smoke sensors installed in laboratories, libraries, and IT centers.
- 24/7 student emergency hotline: (71) 230-21-07.
- Automatic incident notification system linked to the MIA branch and emergency services.

Sustainability and Safety Integration

- Use of **solar-powered lamps** and **energy-efficient monitoring devices** reduces campus power consumption by 14%.
- Safe pedestrian and cycling routes equipped with **eco-lighting** and emergency call posts.
- Safety awareness is included in the "Barqaror Til, Barqaror Dunyo (Sustainable Language, Sustainable World)" sustainability education program.
