6.26 Impact of Education and Research programs in supporting the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Introduction

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) recognizes the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) as a strategic framework for its educational, research, and community missions.

Through its academic programs, scientific research, digital transformation, and social outreach, UzSWLU aims to prepare global citizens who contribute to sustainability, equality, and peace.

The university's development policy, "Sustainable Language – Sustainable World", launched in 2021, fully aligns with Uzbekistan's Green Growth Strategy and the UN's 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

UzSWLU currently contributes to **16 out of the 17 SDGs**, demonstrating its holistic approach to sustainability in higher education.

1. Integration of SDGs into Education

Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) is embedded in all study programs at UzSWLU. Over **85% of undergraduate and graduate programs** include sustainability-related components.
