6. Education and Research

6.6 Total research funds (in US Dollars)

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) allocates significant resources annually to support scientific research, innovation, and academic development within its strategic framework **“Research and Innovation Development Strategy 2023–2030.”**

Research funding covers a wide range of areas, including:

- Fundamental and applied linguistics, translation studies, and digital humanities;
- Educational technology and AI-assisted language learning;
- Sustainability, green campus development, and climate-related innovation;
- Social inclusion, gender equality, and community-based education projects;
- Teacher and student research grants, publications, and international cooperation programs.

Funds are provided from **three main sources**:

1. **State Budget Allocations** (via the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation);
2. **Internal University Research Funds** (annual grants and staff research incentives);
3. **External Grants and Partnerships** (international cooperation projects with BINUS University, Assumption University, Istanbul Aydın University, and others).

- Publication of **over 120 articles** in Scopus, Web of Science, and national journals.
- Establishment of the **Commercialization Department** supporting innovative patents and prototypes.
- Creation of the **Green Office Research Cluster** uniting sustainability-related researchers.

Impact and Evaluation

- Annual reports are prepared by the Research and Innovation Department and reviewed by the Rector's Council.
- Research outcomes are integrated into the **University Digital Sustainability Report** and the **National Research Portal**.
- Funding structure reviewed yearly to maintain balance between linguistic, pedagogical, and sustainability-focused studies.
- Continuous growth in external collaboration funding, especially from **Erasmus+, British Council, and DAAD** programs.
