Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) prepares specialists who contribute to the social, cultural, and environmental dimensions of sustainable development. Graduates of UzSWLU play an important role in promoting sustainability through professions that involve teaching, translation, journalism, international cooperation, early childhood education, and social innovation.

These areas, though not purely technical, are directly linked to sustainability education, environmental awareness, cultural preservation, and responsible communication. Through its Career and Alumni Center, Green Office, and Startup Incubation Hub, the university consistently tracks and supports the employment of graduates in green and sustainability-oriented careers.

Over the last three years (2023–2025), a total of 16,207 students graduated from UzSWLU, and 1,380 of them ($\approx 8.5\%$) have been employed in sustainability-related positions. This reflects the university's successful integration of Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) principles into teaching, professional training, and international cooperation.

2. Translation and International Cooperation

- Translators and interpreters for international sustainability and climate projects under **UNDP, KOICA, JICA, TIKA, and Erasmus+**.
- Specialists providing linguistic and analytical support for SDG reporting and environmental communication.

3. Journalism and Communication

- Journalists and PR specialists producing eco-media content, sustainability campaigns, and SDG awareness videos.
- Communication experts in ministries and NGOs promoting responsible and inclusive environmental behavior.

4. Community Development and NGOs

- Alumni working in **Youth Affairs Agency, Ecological Party**, and local environmental organizations.
- Coordinators of educational, equality, and climate-awareness projects in partnership with civic groups.

5. Tourism and Cultural Sustainability

- Eco-tourism guides, tour operators, and cultural managers promoting sustainable heritage and responsible travel.

6. Entrepreneurship and Innovation

- Graduates involved in university-based startups such as **Resin Art, Mohir Qullar, EcoLingua**, and **Smart Campus Hub**, which focus on eco-products, social inclusion, and green communication.
