6.22. Total Number of Graduates (for the Last 3 Years)

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) continues to expand its academic and social impact by preparing a growing number of highly qualified specialists in the fields of foreign languages, translation, journalism, international relations, philology, education, preschool pedagogy, and social sciences.

Over the past three years, the total number of graduates has steadily increased, reflecting both the university's expanding academic capacity and the growing national demand for multilingual professionals.

This increase is also supported by the launch of **new faculties**, including the **Angren Campus**, and the continuous modernization of educational programs under Uzbekistan's Higher Education Reform Strategy 2030.

Between 2023 and 2025, UzSWLU produced a total of 16,207 graduates, marking a 25% growth in graduation output compared to the previous three-year cycle.
