Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) actively promotes sustainability-oriented education and career development across all its faculties.

Through a combination of sustainability-integrated curricula, Green Office initiatives, and strategic partnerships with employers, the university ensures that a growing share of its graduates work in fields contributing to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Over the past three years (2023–2025), the proportion of UzSWLU graduates employed in green and sustainability-related professions has steadily increased. Graduates now occupy positions in eco-education, sustainable journalism, translation for environmental projects, cultural sustainability, social innovation, and entrepreneurship.

On average, **8.5% of all UzSWLU graduates** in the past three years have been employed in green jobs — a result that places the university among the top-performing humanities institutions for sustainability integration in education and employment.

Interpretation

The percentage of graduates employed in green jobs rose from **8.0% in 2023** to **8.9% in 2025**, showing a **consistent upward trend**.

This growth is driven by the university’s integration of sustainability education into **translation, pedagogy, journalism, and international relations** curricula.

Many graduates work as:

- **teachers of eco-integrated subjects,**
- **translators and communication officers in international sustainability projects,**
- **eco-journalists,**
- **social entrepreneurs and startup founders** under initiatives such as *Resin Art*, *EcoLingua*, *Smart Campus Hub*, and *Mohir Qullar*.
