6. Education and Research

6.8 Number of Lecturers and Researchers on Campus in One-Year Period

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) is a national leader in linguistic and pedagogical education, employing a highly qualified academic community that delivers both teaching and research excellence.

As of **2024**, the university employs **1,186 academic and research staff members**, maintaining a **student–lecturer ratio of approximately 15:1** for its **17,000+ students**. This balance ensures personalized instruction, quality supervision, and a strong research culture across all **10 faculties**, including the newly established **Angren Campus Faculty**.

The **Faculty of Teaching Foreign Languages (No.1, 2, and 3)** remains the largest cluster, with more than **50 professors** and over **430 lecturers**, serving nearly **7,000 students**. All academic data, including staff profiles and research engagement, are digitally monitored through the **Digital Academic Management System (DAMS)** operated by the university’s ICT Center.

Institutional Profile and Research Capacity

UzSWLU's lecturers and researchers are at the heart of the university's research and innovation ecosystem. Each year, more than **250 academic projects** are implemented, covering linguistics, translation studies, artificial intelligence in language education, and sustainability-focused initiatives.

The **Faculty of Teaching Foreign Languages (No.1, 2, and 3)** leads nationwide teacher education and digital pedagogy innovation.

Research is supported by the **Green Office**, which coordinates sustainability programs, and the **Commercialization Department**, which provides internal innovation grants.

Professional Development and International Collaboration

- Over **400 faculty members** have undergone professional training in the past two years through **Erasmus+**, **DAAD**, **British Council**, and national initiatives.
- Academic mobility and joint research projects connect UzSWLU with **BINUS University (Indonesia)**, **Assumption University (Thailand)**, **Istanbul Aydın University (Türkiye)**, and **Beijing Foreign Studies University (China)**.
- The **Angren Campus** broadens UzSWLU's regional academic reach and serves as a model for sustainable multilingual education.

ICT Integration



All lecturers and researchers are registered in the **Digital Academic Management System (DAMS)** — a centralized ICT platform integrating research productivity, publications, and sustainability indicators.

The system generates annual digital reports for institutional transparency and global ranking submissions (UI GreenMetric, QS, THE Impact).
