Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) allocates substantial financial resources each year to promote sustainability-focused research, innovation, and infrastructure development in line with the Sustainability Research and Innovation Framework (2023–2030).

These research funds integrate environmental, social, and technological sustainability priorities, covering projects related to:

- Green construction and energy efficiency (smart buildings, solar panels, and eco-materials);
- Social inclusion (financial assistance and scholarships for students from low-income families);
- **Human capital development** (teacher training, professional certification, and sustainability workshops);
- Research commercialization and innovation (grants for sustainable inventions and ecoinnovation projects);
- **Digital transformation for sustainability** (ICT-based monitoring, AI, IoT systems);
- Campus greening and climate action programs.
