6.19. Number of Community Services Related to Sustainability Organized by the University and Involving Students

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) has established a strong culture of **social responsibility and community engagement** as a vital part of its sustainability mission. Every year, the university organizes numerous community service activities that involve thousands of students and faculty, addressing **environmental, social, and educational sustainability goals**.

These initiatives aim to improve the lives of vulnerable groups, empower local communities through education, and strengthen environmental stewardship in Tashkent and regional areas.

All programs are implemented under the coordination of the **Green Office**, the **Youth Union**, and the **Department of Social Affairs**, with the active leadership of university volunteers.

In 2024, UzSWLU carried out **more than 150 sustainability-related community service projects**, engaging over **10,000 participants**, including students, staff, and local residents.

Highlights of Community Engagement Activities (2024)

- **Volunteer Network for Social Care:**
A dedicated student volunteer group regularly visits **elderly care homes, children’s shelters, and disability centers**, organizing festive concerts, cultural performances, and donation campaigns.
During 2024, they held **monthly charity visits**, distributed hot meals and collected over **2,000 clothing items** for families in need.
- **Free Community Education Programs:**
University lecturers and students launched free **foreign language, IT, and vocational training courses** in collaboration with local schools and mahalla committees.
More than **600 schoolchildren and adults** received certificates after completing these community learning programs.
- **Sports for All Initiative:**
The **Department of Physical Education** runs **free karate, kurash, boxing, football, basketball, and field hockey clubs** for children living near the university.
Around **250 children** regularly attend weekly sessions in the university’s sports complex, promoting physical health, teamwork, and social inclusion.
- **“Clean Campus – Clean City” & “1 Student – 1 Tree” Campaigns:**
Over **2,000 trees planted** and **local parks cleaned** through joint student–community actions in partnership with the Ecological Party and city authorities.
- **Charity and Solidarity Events:**
Students held **blood donation campaigns**, “Warm Winter” clothing drives, and “Kindness Box” collections for families in difficult living conditions.
- **Green Youth Caravan:**
Student volunteers visited rural schools and colleges in Tashkent region to deliver **eco-awareness lessons** and interactive workshops on sustainability and climate action.

Impact and Outcomes

- **150+ community-based sustainability actions** carried out in 2024.
- **10,600+ participants** including students, faculty, and local residents.
- **Over 3 hectares of public areas cleaned or greened** through environmental programs.
- **More than 600 beneficiaries** completed community-led free language and IT courses.
- **250+ children** regularly engaged in sports and wellbeing activities.
- **2,000+ trees planted, 8 tons of recyclables collected, 2,000+ clothing items donated.**



- **15+ institutions (orphanages, elderly homes, disability centers)** directly benefited from UzSWLU's volunteer initiatives.
