6.11. Number of events related to sustainability

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) conducts an extensive range of **sustainability and environmental events** every year, aiming to promote ecological literacy, social responsibility, and community participation in line with the **UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**.

The university's **Green Office**, in collaboration with the **Department of Natural Sciences, Youth Union, and Student Environmental Club**, coordinates these activities across all faculties and campuses (including the Angren branch).

Each year's agenda includes seminars, clean-up campaigns, green weeks, hackathons, conferences, and student-led environmental initiatives, all tracked through the **Digital Sustainability Calendar (DSC)** system.

30 interdisciplinary student projects proposed sustainable campus innovations.

7Zero Waste Day (June 2024)

8 tons of recyclable materials collected; awareness sessions on circular economy.

Clean Air & Bicycle Day (September 2024)

Cycling marathon with 500 participants; awareness about urban air quality.

1 Student – 1 Tree” Campaign (November 2024) *Nationwide initiative: 2,000 trees planted at main and Angren campuses.*

SDG Education Forum (December 2024)

Green Office & UNESCO National Commission partnership; 20 papers on sustainability education.

- **Campus Clean-Up and Recycling Drives** – continuous volunteer initiatives under the *EcoCampus Project*.
