### [6.8] Number of university sustainability programs with international collaborations

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) maintains a broad and well-established system of international cooperation in sustainability and higher education development. Currently, the university has over 400 active Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with foreign universities, educational institutions, and international organizations.

Within this network, UzSWLU collaborates closely with major international partners such as **DAAD** (Germany), KOICA (Korea), JICA (Japan), TIKA (Türkiye), and the Erasmus+ program (European Union), as well as with numerous universities and sustainability networks across Asia, Europe, and the Middle East.

These collaborations support joint initiatives in environmental education, sustainable campus development, teacher training, eco-communication, climate literacy, digital transformation, and SDG-oriented policy exchange.

In 2024, the university implemented or participated in **ten international sustainability-focused collaborations** aimed at strengthening environmental and social responsibility across education and research.
