On the Implementation of the Mandatory Annual Training Program on Environmental Sustainability “Sustainable Language, Sustainable World”

In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PF-5863 dated October 30, 2019 “On the Strategy for Transition to Green Economy,”

The Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated December 31, 2020 “On measures for implementing sustainable development goals in higher education institutions,”

The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 4, 12, 13),

The UI ~~GreenMetric~~ World University Rankings criteria and THE Impact Rankings indicators,

And within the framework of the University’s “Green University” initiative, with the aim of enhancing environmental literacy among staff,

I HEREBY ORDER:

1. Starting from the 2022-2023 academic year, a mandatory annual training program on environmental sustainability titled “Sustainable Language, Sustainable World” shall be implemented for all faculty and administrative staff of the University.
2. The training program shall be conducted in a blended format of 20 hours: 15 hours of theoretical sessions and 5 hours of practical assignments.
3. The program shall consist of the following 6 modules:
 - Module 1: Sustainability in Higher Education — 3 hours
 - Module 2: Resource Efficiency & Green Campus — 4 hours
 - Module 3: Eco-Pedagogy — 3 hours
 - Module 4: Digital Sustainability — 3 hours
 - Module 5: Climate & Environmental Awareness — 4 hours
 - Module 6: Language & Sustainability Communication — 3 hours
4. One training coordinator shall be appointed from each faculty. Coordinators shall ensure full implementation of the program.
5. A dedicated assessment tool for evaluating staff sustainability literacy and knowledge shall be implemented. Assessment shall be conducted through pre-training and post-training surveys as well as a final practical assignment.
6. Staff members who successfully complete the training shall receive a certificate endorsed by the University.
7. A dedicated monitoring commission shall be established to oversee the implementation and outcomes of the training program. The commission shall analyze annual results and submit a report to the Rectorate.

8. The program plan and schedule shall be submitted for approval by October 1 of each academic year.
9. Information on program outcomes and staff sustainability literacy shall be regularly published on the University's official website.
10. Oversight of the execution of this order is assigned to the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs.
