



# UZBEKISTAN STATE UNIVERSITY OF WORLD LANGUAGES “EcoLingua” Student Sustainability Society

## CHARTER

*Approved by the Student Council on October 5, 2022*

---

### Article 1: Name and Status

- 1.1. The official name of the organization is “EcoLingua — Student Sustainability Society of UzSWLU.”
- 1.2. EcoLingua is a voluntary, student-led organization operating under the Student Council of Uzbekistan State University of World Languages.
- 1.3. The society was established by Rector’s Order No. 312-T dated September 20, 2022.

### Article 2: Mission and Objectives

2.1. Mission: To engage students in environmental sustainability through language education, communication, and community action.

2.2. Objectives:

- Promote environmental awareness among students, staff, and the local community
- Organize sustainability-focused events, campaigns, and educational activities
- Create multilingual content on environmental topics to bridge language and sustainability
- Support the university’s Green University initiative and UI GreenMetric goals
- Develop student leadership skills in sustainability and environmental advocacy
- Collaborate with national and international sustainability networks and organizations
- Contribute to achieving UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs 4, 12, 13, 6, 7)

### Article 3: Membership

- 3.1. Membership is open to all enrolled students of UzSWLU regardless of faculty, year, or program.
- 3.2. Members join voluntarily by submitting an application to the society’s leadership.
- 3.3. Active membership requires participation in at least 3 society events per semester.
- 3.4. Members may hold leadership positions after one semester of active membership.

### Article 4: Organizational Structure

- 4.1. President — elected annually by general vote of active members. Represents the society and coordinates all activities.
- 4.2. Vice-President for Projects — manages campaigns, events, and sustainability initiatives.
- 4.3. Vice-President for Communications — manages social media, website content, and public relations.
- 4.4. Faculty Coordinators — one representative per faculty, responsible for local engagement.
- 4.5. Faculty Advisor — appointed by the Rector from the Department of Ecology and Green Resources.
- 4.6. General Assembly — held once per semester to review activities, elect leadership, and approve action plans.

### Article 5: Activities

5.1. The society shall conduct the following types of activities:

- Eco-forums and sustainability seminars with invited speakers
- Campus and community clean-up campaigns (minimum 4 per year)
- Sustainability Awareness Week (annually in April, aligned with Earth Day)
- Tree planting and campus greening initiatives
- Multilingual sustainability content creation (articles, videos, social media)
- Participation in national environmental competitions and conferences
- Collaboration with other universities' sustainability societies
- Eco-volunteering and community outreach programs
- Waste reduction and recycling awareness campaigns

## Article 6: Reporting and Accountability

6.1. The society shall submit an annual activity report to the Vice-Rector for Youth Affairs.

6.2. Activity records, photos, and reports shall be published on the university website.

6.3. The Faculty Advisor shall submit a summary to the Green University Coordination Office for inclusion in ~~GreenMetric~~ and QS sustainability reporting.

## Article 7: Amendments

7.1. This Charter may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the General Assembly.

7.2. Amendments take effect upon approval by the Student Council and the Faculty Advisor.
