## **1. General Description**

### **Education Direction: 60310100 - Political Science**

The training of bachelors in the education direction 60310100 - Political Science is carried out in full-time forms of education. The standard duration of the undergraduate program in full-time education is 4 years.

#### **1.1. Field of Application**

##### **1.1.1. Application of the Qualification Requirement.**

Qualification requirements represent a set of requirements for all higher education institutions training bachelors in the education direction 60310100 - Political Science.

##### **1.1.2. Main Users of the Qualification Requirement:**

- Management personnel (Rector, Vice-Rectors, Head of the Academic Department, Deans, and Heads of Departments) and the professor-teaching staff of higher education institutions who are responsible for developing and updating qualification requirements, curricula, and syllabi for this education direction, effectively implementing the educational process based on them, and who are responsible for the preparation level of graduates within the scope of their competence;
- Students of the higher education institution who are mastering the curriculum and syllabi of the education direction;
- State Attestation Commissions conducting the assessment of the preparation level of undergraduate graduates;
- Authorized state bodies for education management;
- Bodies ensuring the financing of higher education institutions;
- Authorized state bodies conducting accreditation and quality control of the higher education system;
- Personnel buyers, employing organizations, and enterprises;
- Applicants entering higher education institutions, their parents, and other interested persons.

#### **1.2. Description of Professional Activities.**

### **1.2.1. Spheres of Professional Activity.**

The education direction 60310100 - Political Science is an undergraduate education direction in the field of science, which covers a complex of professional spheres related to the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan and sectoral research institutes, state administration bodies, local government and representative bodies, political parties, governing bodies of non-governmental non-profit organizations, think tanks engaged in the analysis of socio-political processes, political analysis expert groups, political consulting, and political marketing.

### **1.2.2. Objects of Professional Activity:**

- The defense system of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the State Security Service, the National Guard, internal affairs bodies, and their research and think tanks;
- Committees and commissions of the Oliy Majlis (Parliament) of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

- State authority and local administration bodies (ministries, committees, agencies, regional and district khokimiyats [governorates]);
- International organizations, international non-governmental organization employees, and the sphere of political management;
- Political technologists, managers of election campaigns, political-linguistic analysts, experts, and public relations managers;
- Civil society institutions;
- The Agency for Information and Development of State Services under the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan and its regional branches;
- Political consulting services in the private sector;
- In the event that graduates in the undergraduate education direction 60310100 - Political Science undergo pedagogical retraining, they shall have the right to engage in pedagogical activity for teaching general professional and specialized disciplines determined by the authorized management bodies of education in professional education institutions.

### **1.2.3. Types of Professional Activity:**

- Research;
- Provision of state-civil services;
- Organizational and managerial;
- Information-analytical activity;
- Military activity.

### **1.2.4. Professional Tasks.**

In accordance with the 6th qualification level of the National Qualifications Framework for the education direction 60310100 - Political Science and the spheres, objects, and types of professional activities of a bachelor, the undergraduate graduate must be capable of performing the following professional tasks:

- Participating in collecting, processing, analyzing scientific-practical information on a topic (assignment), and systematizing the obtained data;
- Participating in the implementation of research results and developments into practice;
- Organizing scientific-practical seminars and conferences, and participating with articles in scientific and analytical popular publications;
- Applying modern political analysis methods and technologies to practical processes;
- Being aware of research results relevant to modern political processes, and being able to apply them from the perspective of national interests;
- Recommending and utilizing scientifically grounded systems;

- Must possess the capabilities to carry out activities in organizing research work related to the field of political sciences and participating in the implementation of advanced research results and developments into practice.

### **In the Activity of Providing State-Civil Services:**

- Knowing current issues of civil society;
- Possessing a systematic set of modern knowledge related to the worldview, being able to analyze independently, and being able to use them effectively in professional activity;
- Knowing the history of one's homeland, being able to express one's opinion on issues of national and universal values, and being able to justify them scientifically;
- Organizing the implementation of field-related innovations into practice;
- Mastering the ability and qualities to organize teamwork;
- Implementing solutions to professional problems into practice;
- Making management decisions under conditions of diversity of opinions;
- Monitoring and evaluating the results of implemented work;
- Possessing the ability to develop and implement methods and measures to ensure safety during the labor process;
- Organizing management in the strategic development of organizations, enterprises, and state agencies by applying foreign and national political knowledge to the management system;
- Being able to introduce competence-based learning models in the training and advanced training of civil servants;
- Implementing a system for evaluating the effectiveness of civil service activity;
- Assessing the degree of ensuring the execution of specific indicators assigned to the structural block of a state body (departmental and regional organizations);
- Continuously increasing the professional preparation level of employees, applying innovations to work activity, introducing achievements of political sciences abroad into

- the work process, rationally utilizing labor resources, and bringing new KPI (key performance indicator) methods of labor stimulation into the management process;
- Applying "digital management processes" in labor activity, organizing modern management methods and a system of working with a team, and implementing new creative methods of continuously increasing the employee motivation process into management processes;
  - Introducing modern mechanisms to increase the quality and accessibility of state services and targeting the activities of civil servants toward the population as consumers of state services.

### **In Organizational and Managerial Activity:**

- Human capital development, continuous education, personnel potential and personnel assessment of the organization, time-management (effective use of time), and working with employee data in the single national labor system;
- Continuously increasing one's professional, theoretical, and practical knowledge, constantly expanding one's worldview, knowledge, and experience, striving to master new knowledge, obtaining new information using information and communication technologies effectively, and studying advanced experiences;

### **In Information-Analytical Activity:**

- Collecting, processing, and analyzing data on factors of the external and internal environment of the organization to make management decisions;
- Collecting information for decision-making, planning, and managing activity, creating the internal information system of the organization, and managing its functioning;
- Developing and managing the internal document circulation system of the organization, and maintaining a database on various indicators of organizations' activities;
- Evaluating the effectiveness of projects;
- Preparing reports based on the results of information-analytical activity;
- Evaluating the effectiveness of management decisions.
