1. General Description

70230104 - Literary Studies Master's Specialization

The Master's specialization 70230104 - Literary Studies is implemented in full-time forms of education that train masters. Education across all forms of study is organized on the basis of the credit-module system. The normative duration of the Master's program is 2 years.

1.1. Scope of Application

1.1.1. Application of the Qualification Requirement:

The Qualification Requirement represents the set of requirements for all higher education organizations training masters under the specialization 70230104 - Literary Studies.

1.1.2. Main Users of the Qualification Requirements:

- Management staff of the higher education organization (rector, vice-rectors, head of the academic department, deans, and heads of departments) and professors-teachers who are responsible for developing and updating the qualification requirements, curriculum, and science programs for this master's specialization, effectively implementing the educational process based on them, and who are responsible for the level of preparation of graduates within their scope of authority;
- Students of the higher education organization who master the curriculum and science programs of the master's specialization;
- State Attestation Commissions that evaluate the level of preparation of master's graduates;
- State bodies authorized for education management;
- Bodies providing financing for higher education organizations;
- Authorized state bodies conducting accreditation and quality control of the higher education system;
- Personnel ordering entities and employer organizations and enterprises;
- Bachelor's graduates entering higher education organizations and other interested persons.

1.2. Description of Professional Activities

1.2.1. Fields of Professional Activities:

The Master's specialization 70230104 - Literary Studies encompasses a comprehensive set of issues related to the specialization in higher, professional development, and retraining institutions within the scope of Uzbek literature, the studied literature, world literature, comparative literary studies, theory and practice of comparative literary studies, theory of literature, history of Uzbek literature, history of the studied literature, world literature and folklore of the ancient period, history and theory, history of world literary studies, folklore of the studied peoples, modern literature of the studied country, foundations of artistic analysis, methodology of literary studies, foundations of scientific research, philosophy of literature; teaching Uzbek language and literature sciences in general education, secondary special, and vocational education institutions; conducting scientific research work in scientific research centers and scientific-production associations of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan and network scientific research institutes; and working in production and service enterprises of various forms of ownership, state administration bodies, and industrial and business organizations of different forms of ownership.

1.2.2. Objects of Professional Activities:

- Conducting pedagogical activity on sciences related to the specialization in higher education, retraining and professional development, general secondary, secondary special, and professional education institutions;
- Implementing scientific and practical research, theoretical and practical analysis, and modeling in the field of literary studies at the Academy of Sciences, network scientific research institutes and centers, as well as higher education institutions;
- Conducting activity in state and local administration bodies;
- Obtaining the right to organize and manage translation and clerical work in state, non-governmental, and private organizations;
- Conducting activity in mass media, editorial offices of newspapers and magazines, and publishing houses.

1.2.3. Types of Professional Activities:

- Scientific research activity;
- Spiritual and educational activity;
- Organizational and managerial activity;
- Pedagogical activity: scientific-pedagogical activity in higher, professional development, and retraining education institutions, as well as pedagogical activity in the general education, secondary special, and vocational education system (in the established order);
- Includes rendering various services and similar activities.

1.2.4. Professional Tasks:

In accordance with the 7th qualification level of the National Qualifications Framework for the specialization 70230104 - Literary Studies and the fields, objects, and types of professional activities of the master, the master's graduate must be capable of performing the following professional tasks:

In Scientific Research Activity:

- Purposefully searching and finding information on the Internet about the latest scientific, design, technological, and operational achievements;
- Organizing, conducting, and actively participating in international scientific seminars, conferences, and symposia;
- Developing local and international scientific projects on the specialization topic;
- Developing conceptual and theoretical models of the scientific problems and tasks being solved;
- Must possess the ability to develop scientific reviews, compile abstracts and bibliographies on the topic of the ongoing research.

In Spiritual-Educational Activity:

- Being able to plan spiritual-educational work, mastering its organization methodology, instilling a love for spiritual heritage, a thirst for healthy beliefs, and the idea of mutual compassion into the minds of students;
- Knowing the methods and technologies for forming immunity in students against ideological and informational attacks;
- Conducting explanatory work on the role and influence of written spiritual heritage in the processes occurring under globalization conditions;
- Conducting individual conversations on matters of spiritual-moral education in neighborhoods;
- Revealing universal human values, mercy, tolerance, patriotism, and loyalty as high human qualities during the conduct of national customs and ceremonies.

In Organizational-Managerial Activity:

- Organizing and managing social and spiritual-educational work in a team;
- Being able to make organizational-managerial decisions in non-standard situations and take responsibility for these decisions;
- Drawing up a work plan for the activity being performed, executing it, monitoring it, and evaluating the results of the implemented work;

- Organizing corporate training based on electronic learning (e-learning) and mobile learning (m-learning) technologies and developing corporate databases;
- Participating in the control of production processes regarding compliance with environmental protection and labor safety requirements;

- Must possess the ability to act as a manager for spiritual-educational work in non-governmental and non-profit organizations, and private entrepreneurship subjects.

In Pedagogical Activity:

- Mastering teaching methodology;
- Conducting theoretical and practical sessions on academic disciplines provided for in the direction of preparation related to the specialization in higher education, general education, secondary special, and vocational education system institutions;
- Conducting non-traditional training sessions using modern informational and pedagogical technologies;
- Compiling, preparing, and finalizing educational-methodological documents required for conducting classes on the taught disciplines;
- Using technical means of education to conduct training sessions on the taught discipline;
- Regularly improving oneself in various methods, tools, and other areas in the field of the taught discipline and pedagogical activity as a result of independent education and creative search;
- Must possess the ability to develop State Education Standards, Qualification Requirements, State Requirements, and other educational-normative documents for the field of humanities.

Rendering Various Services:

- Consulting service suitable for the specialization;
- Scientifically studying the history of literary studies, illuminating processes from the perspective of objective and impartial scientific character;
- Having precise information on researched topics;
- Implementing methodological activity related to the ability to use libraries, information-resource centers, periodical press pages, and archive data;
- Being able to read and utilize ancient manuscript and lithographic sources;
- Rendering paid educational services;
- Must possess the abilities to render research work and other services based on state grants and business contracts on a topic suitable for the specialization.

2. Requirements for Professional Competencies:

- Must have mastered the system of knowledge related to the scientific worldview, know the foundations of general methodological sciences, and current issues of state policy;
- Must possess the ability to independently analyze social problems and processes;
- Must express one's thoughts orally and in writing relying on national-spiritual and universal human values, and know the essence of the main idea of "Building the Foundation of the Third Renaissance" along with its harmony and difference from main ideas while understanding the theoretical foundations of the national idea;
- Must be able to apply legal and ethical norms regulating a person's relationship with humans, society, and the environment in professional activity;
- Must be able to independently acquire and improve new knowledge, organize one's work on a scientific basis, creatively and critically review and analyze acquired knowledge, and use them in scientific activity;

- Must use the basic laws of disciplines mastered in professional activity, classify methods, and use methodological principles in scientific activity;
- Must use informational and pedagogical technologies in pedagogical activity, and innovatively approach the enhancement of education quality and efficiency;
- Must master the methods of collecting, storing, processing, and utilizing information;
- Must be able to make reasoned independent decisions in one's professional activity;
- Must possess the ability to understand the essence and significance of information technologies under today's information society conditions, comprehend the danger of informational attacks and threats, and comply with the basic requirements of information security;
- Must know the basic methods and tools of obtaining, storing, and processing information from the Internet network, and have computer skills as an information management tool;
- Must have mastered one of the foreign languages as a tool for scientific communication and professional exchange of qualifications;
- Must possess the skills of preparing a project to participate in projects announced by state, non-governmental, and non-profit organizations; be able to prepare operational normative documents to obtain a patent;
- Systematically studying knowledge related to the classical and modern periods of Uzbek literature, problems of world literary studies, and literature theory;
- Being aware of the development stages of history and progress trends of literary studies;
- Mastering the methodology of teaching special disciplines and using informational and innovative technologies in pedagogical activity;

- Comprehending theoretical regularities related to the poetics of texts of classical poetic and prose works, being able to apply them in scientific activity, and having the skill to analyze texts of classical literature examples;
- Mastering scientific research methodology in literary studies, being able to apply various methods in conducting research;
- Being aware of the foundations of literary studies, literature theory, literary criticism, literary terms, and their theoretical foundations;
- Having the skills to conduct scientific and practical research, process experimental results and draw scientifically based conclusions on their basis, prepare and edit scientific articles, organize and conduct scientific seminars, conferences, and symposia, and develop scientific projects;
- Studying the history of the study of world literature, traditional and avant-garde directions of the methodology of world literary studies, and methods and ways of approaching world literature examples on the basis of national artistic thinking;
- Studying the content and essence, historical-theoretical stages of comparativism, analyzing and interpreting the typological characteristics of Eastern and Western literature examples; deeply understanding the foundations of translation theory, which is an important component of comparative literary studies, and awareness of translation practice, working with text, realities of artistic texts, and problems of pragmatic translation;
- Having scientific information about the term "Historical Poetics", its sources, history of study, literary scholars who researched the problem, and the specific relationship of historical poetics with "theoretical poetics";
- Having knowledge about the problems of periodization of the history of literature of Turkic peoples, folklore of Turkic peoples, ancient myths and legends, their themes,

heroes, transition of plots into written literature, folklore epics and written epics, wandering plots, variation in epics, formation of written literature, religious and secular literature, translation literature, and genres;

- Knowing the genesis of folkloristics, linguofolkloristics, stages of development and history of formation of folklore studies, comprehending regularities regarding historical folklore genres and their poetic characteristics, and being able to apply them in folklore research;
- Knowing stylistic analysis methods used in analyzing artistic text categories and linguistic units expressing artistic text categories, and being able to use them in one's scientific and professional activity;
- Knowing innovative approaches to increasing the quality and efficiency of education;
- Must possess the ability to conduct theoretical sessions on academic disciplines provided for in the direction of preparation in general secondary education institutions, and corresponding educational institutions of the secondary special vocational education and higher education institution systems;

- Must possess the ability to conduct practical and laboratory sessions, including in educational workshops, on academic disciplines provided for in the direction of preparation in general secondary education institutions, and corresponding educational institutions of the secondary special vocational education and higher education institution systems;
- Must possess the ability to form and compile educational-methodical documents required for conducting classes on the taught disciplines;
- Must possess the ability to develop technical means of teaching for conducting sessions on the taught discipline and their exploitation;
- Must possess the ability to regularly improve oneself in the spheres of methods, tools, and forms in the field of the taught discipline and pedagogical activity as a result of independent education and creative search;
- Must possess the ability to develop educational-methodical complexes for electronic (e-learning) and mobile (m-learning) teaching;
- Must understand the essence of documents and works related to one's professional activity in one of the studied Eastern and Western languages, know scientific research and pedagogy methodology, and be able to utilize them in professional activity on a modern scientific basis;
- Knowing the theoretical foundations, history of development stages of the literary studies of the studied country, scientific activity of literary scholars, reading, analyzing, and scientifically reviewing scientific sources, scientific journals, fundamental research, and dissertations related to the specialization;
- Classifying written sources created in the taught Eastern language and determining their evolutionary language characteristics;
- Studying the formation of the science of artistry studies (poetology) in the literature of Eastern peoples, monuments related to artistry studies, and their genesis;
- World literary processes and their influence on the literature of the studied country; changes that occurred in prose and poetry based on literary influence; transformation of artistic style in the processes of influence and mutual influence; the role played by the art of translation in the development of literary relations;
- Must possess qualifications and skills regarding classifying data related to the issue of external influence on the studied literature based on theoretical materials, searching for

and finding necessary materials to research problems therein, and analyzing them on a systematic basis.

3. Requirements for Internships:

Scientific-pedagogical internship is aimed at strengthening theoretical knowledge from general professional and specialization disciplines, harmonizing them with practical (production) processes, and forming relevant practical skills, competencies, and qualifications.

A scientific internship is conducted for the master's specialization.
