[1.8] The Ratio of Open Space Area to Total Area

Overview

This indicator measures the proportion of open (non-built) space within the total campus area of Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU). Open spaces include landscaped gardens, courtyards, pedestrian areas, sports fields, recreation zones, and other outdoor spaces that support education, environmental sustainability, biodiversity, and student well-being.

The calculation is based on the official University Infrastructure Inventory and Property Management Records for the 2026 reporting period.

Total Campus Area (1.5)	181,447.40 m²
Ground Floor Area (building footprint)	31,215.96 m ²
Open Space Area	150,709.40 m²
Open Space Ratio (SI1)	83.06%

Open Space Area = Total Campus Area – Ground Floor Area = 181,447.40 – 31,215.96 = 150,709.40 m²

Open Space Ratio = (Open Space Area ÷ Total Campus Area) × 100 = (150,709.40 ÷ 181,447.40) × 100 = 83.06%

Distribution of Open Space by Campus



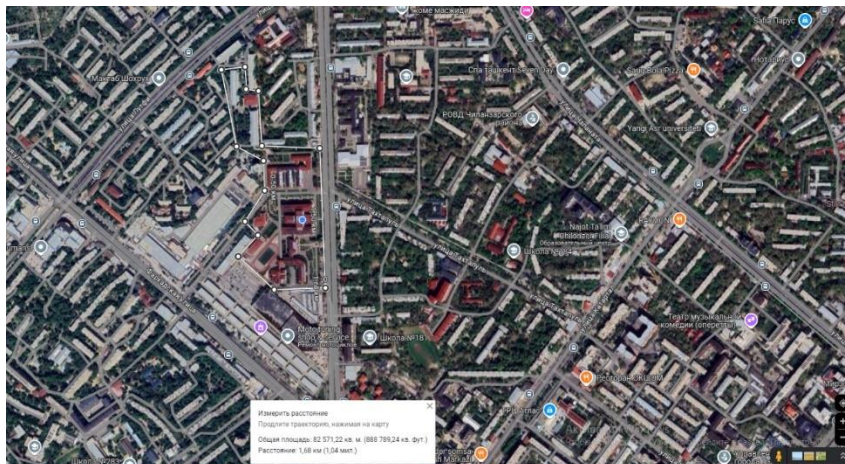

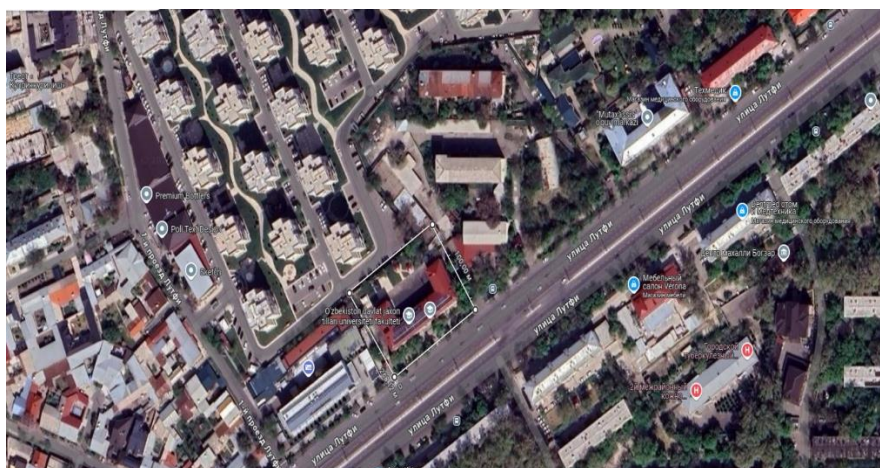

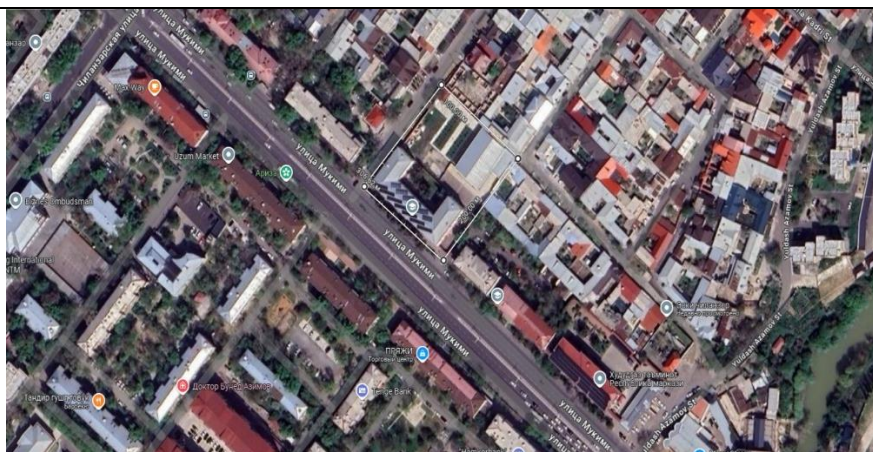
