[1.15] Campus Facilities for Persons with Disabilities, Special Needs, and/or Maternity Care

Overview

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) is committed to creating an inclusive, safe, and accessible campus environment that ensures equal access to education, university services, and campus life for persons with disabilities, individuals with special needs, and parents with young children.

Accessibility and inclusion are integrated into the university's infrastructure development, campus management, and student support system through institutional policies, including the **Inclusive Education Policy**, **Anti-Discrimination and Anti-Harassment Policy**, **Gender Equality Policy**, and the **University Accessibility Guidelines**. These policies guarantee equal opportunities and promote a barrier-free learning environment across all university campuses.

As of 2026, accessibility facilities are fully available and operational in every academic building of the university.

Campus Accessibility Infrastructure

UzSWLU has implemented a comprehensive accessibility system throughout all campuses to ensure safe mobility and equal participation for students, staff, and visitors.

Every academic building is equipped with:

- Permanent wheelchair access ramps;
- Barrier-free pedestrian routes connecting university facilities;
- Tactile paving for persons with visual impairments;
- Braille information signs installed at the entrance of every building;
- Accessible sanitary facilities (toilets);
- Mother-and-baby (nursing) rooms;
- Reserved parking spaces for persons with disabilities;
- Accessible classrooms and lecture halls;



- Accessible libraries, student service centres, and administrative offices.

These facilities allow independent movement and provide equal access to educational, administrative, and recreational services throughout the university.

Accessibility Across University Campuses

Accessibility standards have been implemented consistently across all university campuses.

Zakovat Campus	Wheelchair ramps, tactile paving, Braille building signs, accessible toilets, barrier-free walkways, mother-and-baby rooms, accessible academic buildings
Faculty of Russian Philology	Wheelchair ramps, tactile paving, Braille signage, accessible toilets, barrier-free circulation routes, mother-and-baby rooms
Faculty of International Journalism	Wheelchair ramps, tactile paving, Braille signage, accessible toilets, barrier-free pedestrian routes, mother-and-baby rooms
Angren Campus	Fully accessible academic buildings, wheelchair ramps, tactile paving, Braille signage, accessible toilets, barrier-free routes, mother-and-baby rooms, reserved parking
Orta Chirchiq Recreation and Ecological Complex	Accessible entrances, wheelchair ramps, tactile paving, accessible sanitary facilities, barrier-free recreation routes, mother-and-baby rooms

Inclusive Learning Environment

Accessibility at UzSWLU extends beyond physical infrastructure. The university provides an inclusive educational environment through academic and administrative support services designed to ensure equal participation for all members of the university community.

Students with disabilities and special educational needs have access to:



- Equal admission opportunities;
- Inclusive teaching and learning environments;
- Accessible library services;
- Academic advising and student support;
- Psychological counselling services;
- Medical assistance available on campus;
- Digital learning resources and online educational platforms.

These services support students throughout their academic journey while promoting equal participation in educational and extracurricular activities.

Support for Parents and Maternity Care

To create a family-friendly learning and working environment, the university has established dedicated mother-and-baby rooms in every academic building.

These facilities provide:

- Private nursing areas;
- Baby care facilities;
- Hygienic and sanitary equipment;
- Comfortable seating;
- Safe and quiet childcare spaces.

These facilities are available to female students, university employees, and visitors with young children.

Accessibility Management and Continuous Improvement

Accessibility is an integral component of the university's campus development strategy.

The Facilities Management Department regularly monitors the condition of accessibility infrastructure through scheduled inspections, preventive maintenance, and continuous improvement programmes. Accessibility requirements are incorporated into renovation projects and the development of new university facilities to ensure long-term compliance with institutional standards.

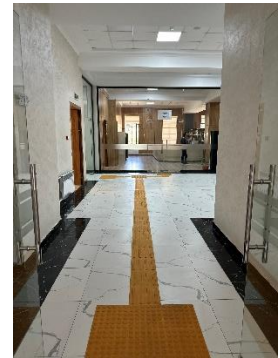
The university also conducts awareness programmes, staff development activities, and student engagement initiatives that promote universal design, equal participation, and respect for diversity.
