[1.16] Security and Safety Facilities

Overview

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) maintains a comprehensive security and safety management system designed to protect students, academic and administrative staff, visitors, and university property across all campuses. The system combines preventive measures, continuous monitoring, emergency preparedness, and rapid response mechanisms to provide a safe and secure learning environment.

Campus security and safety are implemented through institutional regulations, including the **Campus Security Policy, Occupational Health and Safety Policy, Fire Safety Regulations**, and the **Emergency Preparedness and Evacuation Procedure**. These policies define responsibilities, emergency protocols, and regular inspection procedures to ensure the continuous operation of security infrastructure throughout the university.

Security Infrastructure

Security infrastructure is fully available and operational across all university campuses.

The university provides:

- Twenty-four-hour security services at all campuses;
- Comprehensive CCTV surveillance covering academic buildings, administrative offices, student residences, entrances, parking areas, and public spaces;
- Electronic access control and visitor registration systems;
- Campus security posts operating on a continuous basis;
- An on-campus office of the Ministry of Internal Affairs (MIA) providing immediate law enforcement support;
- Direct communication between university security personnel and local police, ambulance, and emergency services.

These measures ensure continuous monitoring and effective incident prevention throughout the university.

Fire and Emergency Safety

All academic buildings are equipped with fire protection and emergency response facilities, including:



- Automatic fire alarm systems;
- Fire extinguishers installed throughout university buildings;
- Fire hydrants and firefighting equipment;
- Clearly marked emergency exits;
- Evacuation maps displayed in academic and administrative buildings;
- Emergency lighting and directional safety signage;
- First-aid stations and medical support facilities.

Regular inspections and maintenance ensure that all safety equipment remains fully operational.

Emergency Response

UzSWLU maintains a coordinated emergency response system capable of responding to accidents, fires, security incidents, and natural disasters.

Emergency response is supported through:

- On-duty university security personnel;
- Immediate coordination with the on-campus Ministry of Internal Affairs office;
- Direct communication with the Fire and Rescue Service, Emergency Medical Service, and local authorities;
- Clearly defined emergency reporting procedures;
- Rapid incident notification and response mechanisms.

The university's emergency response time for accidents, crime, fire, and natural disasters is **less than five minutes** within campus premises.

Safety Awareness and Preparedness

The university conducts regular activities to strengthen campus safety awareness and emergency preparedness.

These include:

- Fire evacuation drills;
- First-aid training programmes;
- Emergency preparedness exercises;
- Occupational health and safety briefings;
- Orientation sessions for newly admitted students and newly employed staff;
- Safety awareness campaigns conducted throughout the academic year.

These activities ensure that students and employees understand emergency procedures and respond effectively during emergency situations.

Digital Security and Monitoring

Security operations are supported by modern digital technologies, including:

- Centralized CCTV monitoring;



- Electronic access control systems;
- Emergency communication channels;
- Digital incident reporting and notification systems;
- Continuous monitoring of university facilities by trained personnel.

This integrated approach improves operational efficiency and enhances campus safety.

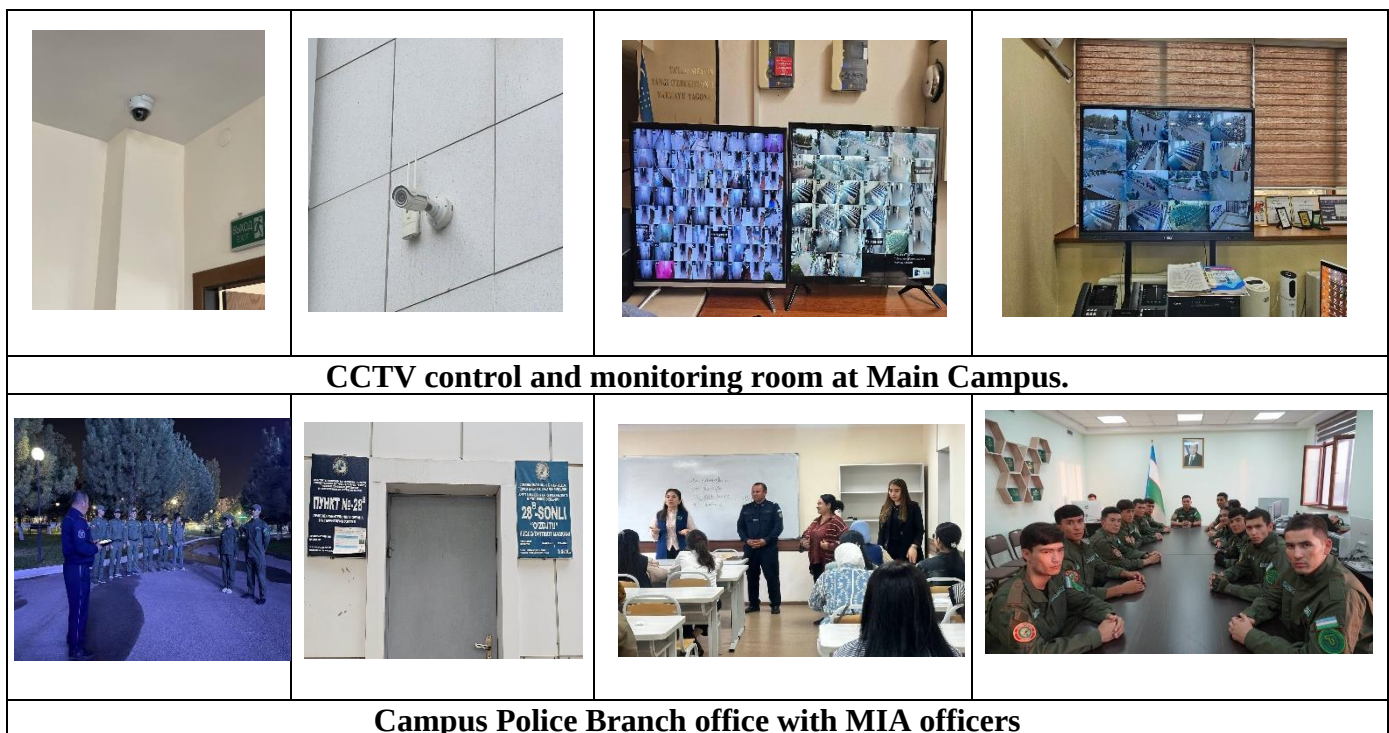
Sustainability and Safe Campus Environment
