4 Water

[4.1] WR1 Total Area on Campus for Water Absorption (Besides Forest and Planted Vegetation)

This indicator measures the percentage of ground surfaces on campus that support water absorption — such as permeable pavement, infiltration areas, and engineered drainage — excluding forest and planted vegetation areas already counted under the Setting & Infrastructure (SI) category.

Basis for This Indicator

UzSWLU's Water Pollution Control programme (indicator 4.5) documents a sustainable stormwater and green drainage system comprising permeable pavement in parking and pedestrian zones, vegetated bioswales and retention ponds, sediment retention systems, and rainwater diversion infrastructure. As a direct result of this programme, green drainage coverage expanded from 70% (2023–2024) to 95% of university territory by 2026.

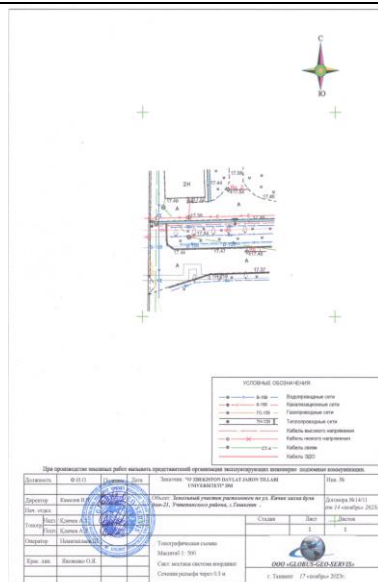
As part of the Water Conservation Program, we have conducted a number of activities aimed at conserving water resources and reducing water consumption at our university.

1. Conducted an audit of the water supply system and identified the main sources of water losses.
2. Installed water meters to monitor its flow.
3. Replaced outdated faucets



and plumbing with more modern and water-saving models. 4. Organized regular inspections of the condition of water pipes and equipment to prevent leaks. The university's contract with the city water supply (UzSWLU) 5. Conducted information campaigns among students and university staff aimed at raising awareness of the importance of water conservation. 6. We have developed an incentive system for those who actively participate in the program and follow the principles of rational use of water. 7. We regularly monitor and analyze the results of the program to assess its effectiveness and make necessary adjustments. 8. As a result of the activities carried out, it was possible to significantly reduce water consumption at the university, which led to savings in utility bills. We will continue to work on the implementation of the Water Conservation Program to ensure the sustainable use of water resources at our university and contribute to the preservation of the environment.

This policy outlines UzSWLU's dedication to conserving, restoring, and sustainably managing terrestrial ecosystems, including forests, mountains, and drylands, in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the university's strategic mission. Objectives: The primary objectives of UzSWLU's Environmental Sustainability Policy are to: Conserve the biodiversity and natural resources within and around university lands. Restore degraded ecosystems and natural habitats to their original state. Ensure Sustainable Use of land and resources to promote long-term ecological balance. Scope: This policy applies to all UzSWLU campuses, associated natural lands, and projects undertaken by the university that impact terrestrial ecosystems.
