3.11 (WS.11) Total Volume of Inorganic Waste Treated This Year

Total Volume of Inorganic Waste Treated This Year

During the **2026 reporting period**, Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) treated approximately **53 metric tons** of inorganic waste, representing **72%** of the total **74 metric tons** of inorganic waste generated across all university campuses.

The university applies an integrated waste treatment system that emphasizes waste segregation, recycling, material recovery, and environmentally responsible disposal in cooperation with authorized municipal waste management partners.

Inorganic Waste Treated by Category

Waste Treatment System

Inorganic waste is collected through a campus-wide waste segregation system and transported to authorized treatment and recycling facilities. Plastic, glass, metal, and electronic waste are separated at designated collection points before being transferred to recycling partners.

Waste collection and treatment activities are carried out in cooperation with the Tashkent City "**Maxsus Trans**" **Waste Management Company**, while electronic waste is managed through certified recycling arrangements to ensure environmentally responsible processing.

Monitoring and Verification

Treatment volumes are monitored throughout the year by the Department of Natural Sciences and the Campus Management Division. Annual treatment data are verified using institutional



environmental monitoring records together with monthly waste collection and recycling reports provided by the university's waste management partners.
