5. Transportation

[5.19] Impact of Transportation Programmes in Supporting the SDGs

Between 2023 and 2026, UzSWLU implemented a series of ICT-driven, low-carbon, and socially inclusive transportation programmes generating measurable progress toward multiple SDGs, by integrating digital mobility systems, expanding zero-emission vehicles, and encouraging walking and cycling.

Contribution to the SDGs (Confirmed: 12 SDGs)

SDG	Contribution of Transportation Programmes
SDG 1 – No Poverty	Free and partially subsidized shuttle services reduce daily commuting costs for students and staff, easing the financial burden of transportation, particularly for lower-income members of the university community
SDG 2 – Zero Hunger	Efficient campus logistics and service-vehicle routing support timely, reliable delivery of food supplies to university cafeterias, reducing spoilage and supporting consistent food access for the campus community
SDG 3 – Good Health and Well-being	8.2 km of pedestrian/cycling routes; car-free zones (95%); air quality +22%; traffic incidents –62%
SDG 4 – Quality Education	Reliable, affordable shuttle and public-transport connections ensure equitable access to classes for students commuting from dormitories and outer districts; mobility awareness campaigns embed sustainability learning into campus life
SDG 5 – Gender Equality	Well-lit, GPS-tracked, camera-monitored shuttles and pedestrian corridors provide safe evening mobility for all students and staff, supporting equal and secure access to campus facilities regardless of gender
SDG 7 – Affordable and Clean Energy	6 solar-powered EV charging stations; ZEV fleet ≈58% of vehicles; +68% renewable energy use for transport
SDG 9 – Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure	Smart Mobility Dashboard, IoT sensors, AI traffic optimization, paperless mobility documentation
SDG 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities	Electric shuttles linking campuses and metro; parking reduced 19.1%; partnership with Tashkent City Transport Authority
SDG 13 – Climate Action	CO ₂ emissions –32.3% (19.8t→17.1t); fuel consumption –61%; 95% of campus zones fossil-free

SDG	Contribution of Transportation Programmes
SDG 15 – Life on Land	Conversion of former parking areas (450 m ²) into lawns and tree-lined corridors; more than 340 trees and 520 shrubs planted along pedestrian zones, supporting local biodiversity and pollinator habitats
SDG 16 – Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions	Three-level digital governance (Transport Dept./Green Office/Rector's Council); 97% user satisfaction; ICT Data Protection Policy
SDG 17 – Partnerships for the Goals	Partnerships with the Tashkent City Transport Authority, Tashkent City Electric Transport Authority, and private mobility providers (MyCar, Yandex Go, MyTaxi) for shared, low-emission commuting
