7.18 Anti-Corruption and Integrity System of the University

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) has established an institutional Anti-Corruption and Integrity System to promote transparency, accountability, ethical conduct, and responsible governance across all academic and administrative activities.

The University's integrity framework is implemented in accordance with the **Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan “On Combating Corruption” (No. ZRU-419)**, the **National Anti-Corruption Strategy of Uzbekistan (2023–2027)**, and relevant regulations governing higher education institutions. Institutional implementation is guided by the **UzSWLU Anti-Corruption Policy**, the **Code of Ethics and Academic Integrity**, and internal regulations on compliance, procurement, academic honesty, and conflict-of-interest management.

Institutional Integrity Framework

No.	Component	Institutional Implementation
1	Anti-Corruption Policy	University-wide policy promoting transparency, ethical behaviour, accountability, and prevention of corruption in academic and administrative activities.
2	Code of Ethics and Academic Integrity	Standards governing professional conduct, academic honesty, conflict of interest, and responsible behaviour for staff and students.
3	Anti-Corruption Oversight	Institutional compliance and monitoring coordinated through the University's Compliance and Internal Control mechanisms.
4	Complaint and Whistleblowing Mechanism	Secure procedures allowing students, staff, and stakeholders to report concerns confidentially through official university communication channels.
5	Academic Integrity and Plagiarism Prevention	Mandatory originality checking for academic works and institutional procedures addressing academic misconduct.



6	Transparent Financial and Procurement Procedures	Procurement and financial management conducted in accordance with national legislation and institutional financial control procedures.
7	Conflict of Interest Management	Institutional procedures requiring disclosure and management of potential conflicts of interest in decision-making processes.
8	Ethics Education and Awareness	Regular awareness activities, staff development, and student orientation programmes promoting integrity, ethical conduct, and anti-corruption culture.
9	Digital Governance and Transparency	Digital information systems supporting transparent academic administration, financial management, document management, and institutional reporting.

Description

UzSWLU considers integrity and anti-corruption to be fundamental principles of good university governance. The University's institutional framework combines preventive measures, ethical standards, transparent administrative procedures, digital governance, and continuous awareness activities to strengthen accountability and public trust.

Anti-corruption principles are integrated into academic administration, financial management, procurement, human resources, research activities, student assessment, and institutional decision-making. Academic integrity is promoted through plagiarism prevention procedures, ethical research standards, transparent assessment practices, and clear mechanisms for addressing academic misconduct.

The University also maintains confidential procedures for reporting concerns, protecting the rights of students and staff, and ensuring that complaints are reviewed through established institutional processes. Digital governance systems further enhance transparency by supporting electronic document management, institutional reporting, financial accountability, and traceable administrative workflows.

Regular awareness programmes, ethics training, and integrity campaigns strengthen a culture of honesty, responsibility, and professional ethics throughout the University community.
