Beyond curriculum and funding, the strength of a university's sustainability commitment is reflected in the volume and consistency of its scholarly output. This indicator assesses



research productivity on sustainability topics relative to the size of the academic and research workforce, based on indexed publications (Scopus, Google Scholar) identified through sustainability-related keywords such as green, environment, sustainability, renewable energy, climate change, eco-linguistics, and social sustainability.

UzSWLU's research output spans multiple disciplinary lenses on sustainability: environmental and eco-linguistic studies within the Faculty of Philology; translation and communication research on climate and environmental discourse; social sustainability and inclusive-education research within Pedagogy; and applied health and well-being studies linked to Valeology and Physical Education. This breadth reflects the university's identity as a language-focused institution that channels its disciplinary strengths — linguistics, translation, and communication — toward sustainability themes rather than treating sustainability research as a narrow, siloed activity
