6.10 Number of Lecturers and Researchers on Campus in One-Year Period

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) is one of Uzbekistan's leading higher education institutions specializing in foreign languages, linguistics, translation, teacher education, journalism, and international communication. The University maintains a strong academic community that supports excellence in teaching, research, innovation, and sustainable development.

During the latest reporting period, UzSWLU employed **1,312 academic and research staff members**, supporting approximately **19,850 students** across its academic programmes. This provides a **student-to-academic staff ratio of approximately 15.1:1**, ensuring high-quality teaching, effective academic supervision, and strong research capacity.

Academic staff contribute not only to education but also to interdisciplinary research, international cooperation, curriculum development, sustainability initiatives, innovation projects, and community engagement activities.

Academic Capacity and Research Profile

 - international collaborative research with partner universities worldwide.

Continuous professional development is an important institutional priority.

Academic staff regularly participate in:

- Erasmus+ mobility programmes;
- DAAD academic cooperation;
- British Council capacity-building programmes;
- international conferences and joint research projects;
- visiting scholar programmes;
- faculty exchange initiatives.

International academic cooperation includes partnerships with universities in Indonesia, China, Türkiye, Thailand, Europe, and other regions supporting joint research, curriculum development, and sustainability education.

Contribution to Sustainability

More than **480 academic staff members** actively contribute to sustainability through curriculum development, interdisciplinary research, student supervision, innovation projects, international cooperation, and community engagement.

- environmental linguistics;
- sustainable translation;
- interdisciplinary sustainability research;
- GreenMetric reporting;
- student sustainability activities;
- innovation and entrepreneurship programmes.

Digital Academic Management

Academic activities are supported through integrated digital management systems that monitor staff profiles, research productivity, publications, teaching workload, research performance, and institutional KPIs.

These systems provide verified institutional data for strategic planning, annual reporting, accreditation, and international university rankings, including **UI GreenMetric**, **QS**, and **Times Higher Education**.
