[6.11] Number of Events Related to Sustainability, Averaged Annually over the Past Three Years

Uzbekistan State World Languages University (UzSWLU) organizes a broad range of sustainability-related events involving students, academic staff, researchers, administrative units, and external partners. These events translate the University's sustainability policies, research priorities, and educational activities into direct engagement with the university community and wider society.

For this indicator, UzSWLU reports the **average annual number of sustainability-related events organized over the past three academic years**. The reported data include conferences, seminars, workshops, awareness campaigns, environmental actions, training sessions, public engagement activities, student-led events, and sustainability-themed cultural and educational programmes.

Unlike the indicator measuring activities organized specifically by student organizations, this indicator covers **university-wide sustainability events organized by student organizations, academic faculties, departments, research units, administrative bodies, and external partners in cooperation with UzSWLU**.

Calculation

Average annual number of sustainability-related events = Total events over three years ÷ 3

$$1,110 \div 3 = 370 \text{ events per year}$$

Therefore, the confirmed average annual number of sustainability-related events at UzSWLU over the past three years is **370 events per year**.

Main Categories of Sustainability Events

The University's sustainability event programme covers several major areas:

- **Environmental action and awareness**, including Waste-Free Day, World Cleanup Day, clean-up campaigns, tree-planting activities, waste reduction initiatives, and water conservation awareness;
- **Academic and research events**, including conferences, seminars, and workshops addressing eco-linguistics, climate communication, environmental education, social sustainability, and the Sustainable Development Goals;
- **Health and well-being activities**, including active mobility, healthy lifestyle, mental well-being, and sustainable nutrition programmes;
- **Educational and cultural engagement**, including EcoTalks, SDG debates, sustainability film discussions, multilingual environmental awareness activities, and sustainability-themed exhibitions;
- **Community and international engagement**, including school outreach, environmental volunteering, public awareness activities, and events implemented with governmental, non-governmental, and international partners.

Examples of Sustainability-Related Events

Representative activities include **Waste-Free Day, World Cleanup Day, Save the Planet, Tree Planting for Peace, EcoRun, Bike-to-Campus, EcoTalks, SDG Debate Clubs**, and sustainability-related scientific and educational events organized across the University's faculties and academic units.

Event Organization and Monitoring

Sustainability-related events are organized by student organizations, academic faculties, departments, research units, the Green Office, the Ma'naviyat va Ma'rifat Department, and other relevant University units. Events may also be implemented jointly with government agencies, schools, non-governmental organizations, and international partner institutions.

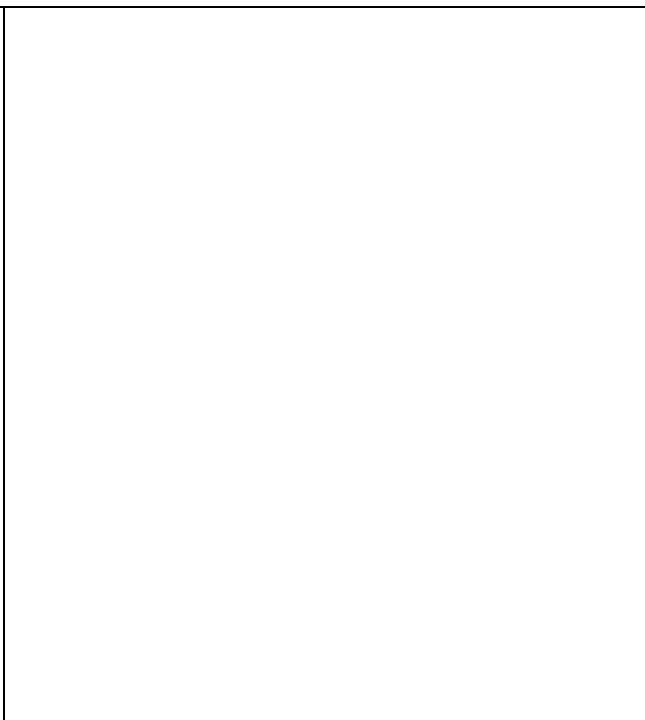
Annual event data are consolidated from faculty and departmental activity reports, student organization records, official event documentation, and University communication channels. This process enables UzSWLU to calculate the average annual number of sustainability-related events consistently across the three-year reporting period.

Impact

The sustained organization of sustainability-related events ensures continuous engagement with environmental, social, educational, and community sustainability themes throughout the academic year. The diversity of event formats allows sustainability engagement to reach students, academic staff, researchers, and external communities through both academic and practical activities.

With an average of **370 sustainability-related events per year over the past three years**, sustainability engagement at UzSWLU is implemented as a continuous university-wide programme rather than being concentrated in individual flagship events.





In connection with the designation of March 30 as Waste-Free Day by the Tashkent Department of Ecology, Environmental Protection, and Climate Change, a clean-up campaign was organized to remove litter collected along the roadsides. This initiative aimed to improve the environment and raise ecological awareness among the public.
