Overall Contribution to Sustainable Development

Uzbekistan State World Languages University's Education and Research programmes make a substantial contribution to the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals by integrating sustainability into teaching, research, innovation, community engagement, and international cooperation.

The University delivers **226 sustainability-related courses and subjects**, including **9 dedicated sustainability-focused study programmes**, while supporting interdisciplinary research, student innovation, community engagement, and international academic collaboration. Sustainability is embedded across linguistics, translation studies, education, journalism, international relations, environmental communication, and related disciplines, ensuring that graduates develop the knowledge and competencies required to address contemporary environmental and social challenges.

Programme Highlights

- **226 sustainability-related courses and subjects**, representing **22.1% of the University's curriculum**.
- **9 dedicated sustainability-focused academic programmes**.
- Integration of sustainability into linguistics, translation studies, pedagogy, environmental communication, journalism, public health, and social sciences.
- Interdisciplinary teaching in eco-linguistics, climate communication, sustainable translation, and global citizenship.
- Dedicated research centres and interdisciplinary research groups addressing sustainability-related themes.
- Publication of **1,630 sustainability-related scientific publications** during the latest reporting period.
- Institutional support for sustainability-oriented research grants, postgraduate research, and student capstone projects.
- **320 sustainability-related activities** organized annually by student organizations.
- An average of **370 sustainability-related events** organized annually across the University.
- International sustainability programmes and academic cooperation with partner universities in Asia, Europe, and other regions.
